TEN Chilling Rules for Halloween in the Garden

1. SET-UP on Friday, Oct. 23, 10:00am-4:00pm. Come on Friday and avoid the rush! You can deliver all your booth supplies/decorations and start setting-up. Please protect things from any little critters and/or the elements!

2. You can also SET-UP on Saturday, Oct. 24, 8:30-10:00am. All participants who want to drop off supplies MUST ENTER through the Front Gate. You will then be directed to a location where you can TEMPORARILY park your car to unload. Once you have unloaded, you MUST move your car to the parking field.

3. PARK YOUR CAR IN THE PARKING FIELD. You can drive into the garden (through the Front Gate) to DROP OFF your supplies, but when you are done unloading, you MUST move your car to the PARKING FIELD. The Front Gate will close promptly at 10:30am and will not reopen for vehicular traffic until after 4:20pm.

4. This is a SMOKE FREE and PET FREE event. Leave your cigarettes and your pets at home. If you are an animal rescue group that wants to have animals at your booth, please contact us to make the necessary arrangements!

5. COME PREPARED FOR THE WEATHER! This is a RAIN or SHINE event; please dress appropriately. If you wish to use a tent, visit the Garden beforehand and check the dimensions of your booth spot. All booth spots are at least 60 sq ft, but trees and vegetation sometimes prohibit the use of a tent. Don't be surprised the day of the event – check beforehand! Please be kind to our woods – do not tie your tent to our trees or put nails in our trees. We suggest sand or water bags to secure your tent.

6. **DECORATE YOUR BOOTH** – have some fun and maybe you will win one of the coveted **GOLDEN PUMPKIN AWARDS** for the best decorated booth! If you donate at least \$100 you can get access to electricity, but you must indicate this on your application.

7. **KID-FRIENDLY COSTUMES!** This is a no-scare, family-friendly event that is predominantly attended by families with **young** children. Please no horrific or overly risqué costumes – keep it clean, please!

8. Hand out ONE family-friendly, kid-friendly GIFT or CANDY to each trick-or-treaters (2000-3000 kids). We suggest you hand out ONE item to each child. By the time a child walks the path, they will have a full bag of goodies. In the past, a number of booths have run out of supplies. This is a well attended event. Please come prepared with extra supplies <u>OR</u> have a back-up plan, i.e. designate someone to go get more goodies.

9. HAND OUT Marketing/Educational Information – You are welcome to hand out information to the kids and the parents, but it must be kid- and family-friendly. No religious or indecent materials are allowed. An Annmarie staff member will check all booths; booths handing out inappropriate materials will be asked to leave.

10. Please don't BREAK YOUR BOOTH DOWN EARLY! It just doesn't look good when you leave early! This event is open to the public from 11:00am until 4:00pm. You can bring your car back into the garden sometime after 4:15pm.
