Please use durable materials and adhesives that can withstand 2 months of outdoor exposure and the attention of enthusiastic visitors. Nails, screw, wire, and other durable anchoring systems are highly encouraged. DO NOT use craft glue or hot glue! Apply multiple coats of varnish or other non-soluble sealant to your completed structure for protection against the elements. All scarecrows must be delivered to Annmarie Sept. 21-25.
