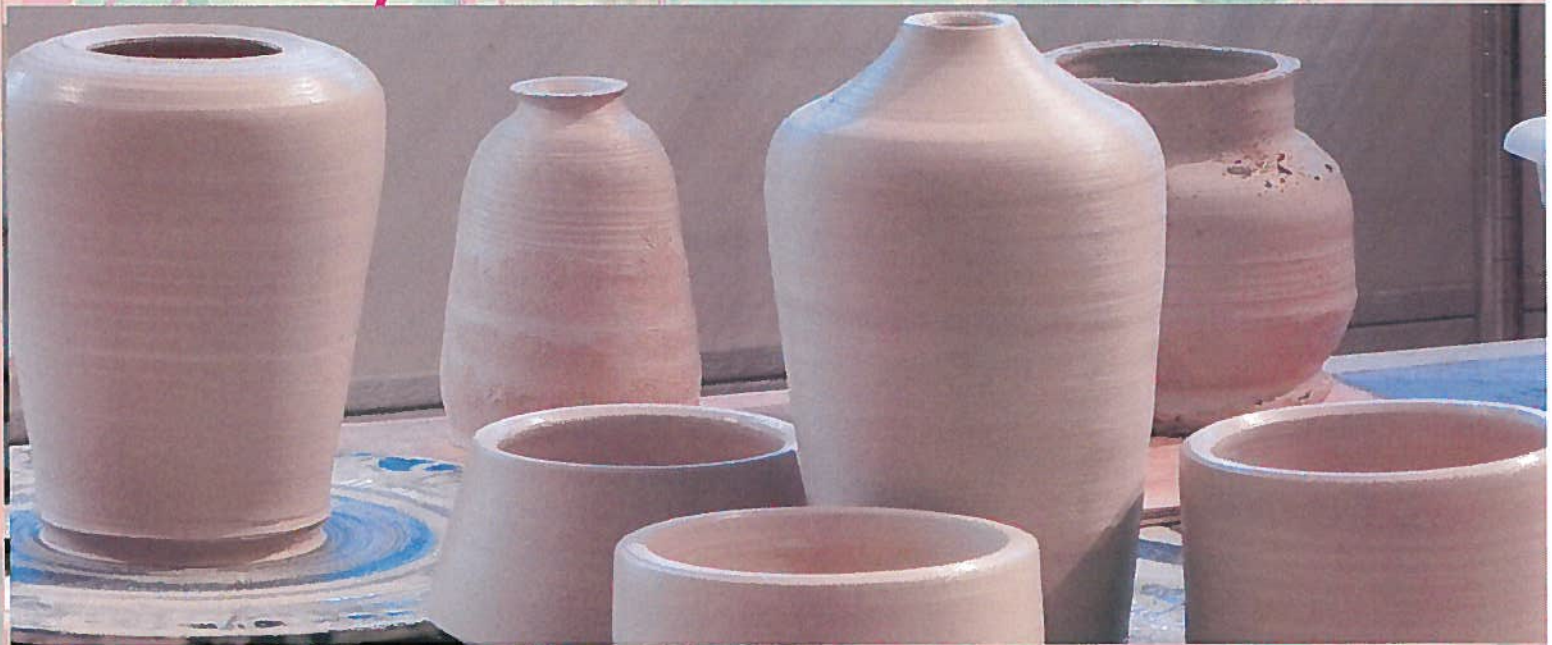

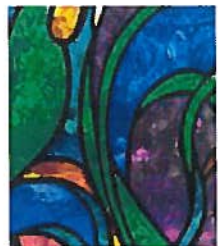

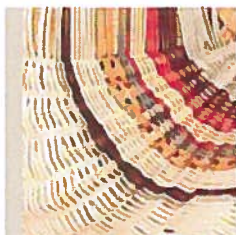
Beginning Basketry: Out-the-Door-Quickly Basket
