Find this sculpture. How many stones do you see? Which one is biggest? Which one is smallest? How do you think they got here?







STOP SIT DOWN. CLOSE YOUR EYES. Listen carefully. Do you hear birds? Try to make the same sounds the birds make.



Find this sculpture. Does this look like a bird? Where is its head? Would this bird flap his wings fast like a hummingbird or slow like an eagle? Pretend you are this bird and flap your wings!



Can you find a caterpillar? How about a butterfly? Be a caterpillar and turn into a butterfly What color are your wings?



Find this sculpture. Look at the twisted metal. What shapes do you see? Can you twist your body into silly shapes?



Act like a flower that is blooming. Start like a seed, then sprout. Now grow leaves, a flower bud, then

BLOOM!



Find this sculpture. Look closely. How many colors do you see? How many fingers do you see? Look at your hand. What is different?



Find this sculpture. Look at the shadow. Do you see the straight lines? Make your shadow look like a straight line. Now make two straight lines. Can you make three?

Find this sculpture. Follow the bridge all the way to the end. What do you see? How many trees grow through the floor of the bridge? Look how high up you are!

Find this sculpture. Watch it move. How many pieces are moving? What color is it? If you could paint it, what color would you choose? Can you move your arms like this sculpture?







Find this sculpture. How many shapes do you see? Do you think this tower looks like it could fall over?

If you could add one more shape on top, what shape would you choose?



Find this sculpture. What animals have heads this big? Do you think this animal had sharp teeth? What do you think it would eat? Pretend to be this creature.





Listen to the water. Look at the tool he uses to scoop the oysters out of the water. These are called tongs. Pretend you are using tongs to scoop oysters out of the water. DO NOT PLAY IN WATER OR CLIMB ON SCULPTURE!
