



Make Your Own Mini Scarecrow

- **Two sticks.** The stick for the arms should be about 16 inches long. The base can be a thicker stick and should be about 20 inches long.
 - **Scarecrow kit** (Includes: the brown paper bag, eyes, nose, mouth, hair, two pieces of string or yarn for tying, a piece or two of jute (for a belt) and some fabric 26 x 8.5 inches with notch cut for the neck hole.)
- A small amount of **glue**
 - Straw, pine needles or dried leaves for **stuffing**
- Find two sticks (sizes given above.) Tie sticks together using yarn/string/ or similar. Save the jute for later use.
 - Fold the fabric in half. Put the "shirt" on by placing the stick through the hole in the fabric.
 - Use the jute to tie the waist.
 - Make the head by stuffing it with straw, pine needles or dried leaves. You will not need to fill the whole bag. Just enough to make the desired size head.
 - Cinch the bag to form the neck. Attach the head by placing it on the stick and tie in place.
 - Use your finger and a small amount of glue to apply the facial features and hair.
 - Add more embellishments if you like. A hat for example. The picture shows a hat made of a circle cut out of a brown paper bag glued onto a small round applesauce cup and tied on with a piece of yarn. Use your imagination!





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
